This scholarship fund was created in 1994 through gifts given in commemoration of Sandra Lippy's Bat Mitzvah. The fund assists teens, age 14 and older, in participating in the March of the Living, summer programs in Israel and Jewish leadership camps/programs.

Jewish continuity and the communal experience is very important to Sandra, who herself studied at an ulpan in Israel. She hopes that, in some small way, this fund will help open the eyes and hearts of young people in the Valley and inspire them to step up to the plate and provide the leadership necessary to maintain a vibrant Jewish community.
