Services Needed and Requirements

Shatter Resistant Windows for the Chapel at Heritage Manor Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center

Requesting proposals to replace current windows in the Chapel at Heritage Manor Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center with shatter resistant windows.

The basic requirements for windows and installation:

- 13 windows 21" x 87" with frames.
- Windows must be fixed, non-operable.
- Glass of 1" clear insulated. Windows must be energy efficient.
- Windows at minimum must be heat-strengthened laminated shatter resistant glass on the interior side.

Submission Process

- Submitters may view the area where the windows will be installed. To view the area, please contact Maintenance Director Rich Parker at rparker@jewishyoungstown.org.
- Submissions must include the proposed cost for the windows and installation and for the removal of the old windows.
- Submissions may be mailed or emailed to the contact information above. Email submissions are preferred.

Evaluation of responses to the RFPs submitted

The Youngstown Area Jewish Federation will evaluate the responses to the RFP and make its determination as to which proposal(s) offer the best value to the Federation on the basis of cost, availability, and business standing in the community. Prior relationship with the company/officer submitting the response will also be considered, but will not be the sole determining factor.
